

Dear Parent,

Welcome to the 2018-2019 school year.

If your student has severe Allergy or Asthma please read the following to help us ensure the health and safety of your child at school.

The following documents must be completed and turned into LMPS by the first day of school:

- The Colorado Allergy/Anaphylaxis Health Care Plan completed by your health care provider and signed by parent/guardian.
- AND/OR -
- Colorado Asthma Health Care Plan completed by a health care provider and signed by parent.
- **All** medications must be in the original pharmacy labeled container **or** in the original packaging for over the counter medications.
- Please check expiration dates on all medications as we will not accept/administer expired medications.
- If your child requires any other medications during the school year, the required form may be obtained from www.lmpsinc.com/ParentLink. All medications must have healthcare provider and parent signature (even over the counter medications).

Immunizations

Colorado law requires all students attending Colorado schools and licensed child care centers to be vaccinated against certain diseases unless an official exemption form is filed.

Required vaccinations:

- HepatitisB/DTap/HIB/Inactivated poliovirus (IPV)/Pneumococcal conjugate (PCV13)/MMR/Varicella (chicken pox).
- Exemption forms may be found at www.colorado.gov/pacific/cdphe/vaccine-exemptions.
- Medical exemptions must be completed by a healthcare provider and need only be completed one time.
- All other exemptions must be completed each time a vaccination is due or prior to each school year.
- If you completed a personal or religious exemption form last school year, it expired on July 1st and will need to be resubmitted.
- All immunizations must be completed and/or exempted by the start of school or your student may be excluded until compliance is complete.
